ROLE OBJECTIVES

The purpose of this role is to provide the essential role of keeping the factory and yard clean, tidy and clear of rubbish. You will be required to maximise recycling in order to maximize waste revenue.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The position requires all paper waste and production waste cages and bins are emptied and replenished regularly throughout your shift. In addition to the requirement to keep the factory and yards clean, you will be responsible for:

- Working alongside your colleagues to ensure that general waste bins are emptied as appropriate;
- Ensure compactor area is clean and dust / waste free;
- Make certain waste is segregated correctly and not mixed by working in line with company processes;
- Carry out good house-keeping tasks to keep the factory area and yard clean and tidy;
- Weeding of external areas as necessary;
- Raise any maintenance and H&S issues to the Shift Operations Manager;
- To cover other duties as and when required;
- To follow the company rules and maintain a safe environment.
